The objectives of the Society are as follows:

The Calgary Track Council is an umbrella organization for Calgary track & field and running clubs and provides a single point of contact between the clubs and the City of Calgary and other organizations. The objective is develop the sport of track and field in Calgary and southern Alberta by providing leadership and encouraging cooperation between clubs.

The activities of the council will be:

- a. To speak with authority for the whole sport when dealing with other groups such as the City, the media, sponsors, other sports groups and the public.
- b. To be the main contact with the City regarding facility needs.
- c. Coordinate booking of facilities and sharing of time at for example Talisman Center, U of C, MRU, Foothills and Glenmore.
- d. Establish and maintain liaison with schools.
- e. Encourage grass roots development of the sport through promotion of the Run Jump Throw program in Elementary schools.
- f. Provide members with a meet management system for hosting competitions (Hytek and Finishlyx with scoreboards).
- g. To provide, own and manage all other equipment needed for hosting competitions.
- h. Assist other communities in southern Alberta with meets.
- i. Develop cooperative fund raising opportunities.
- j. Lead the organization of major track and field competitions in Calgary.
- k. To sell, lease, mortgage, dispose of or other otherwise deal with the property of the Calgary Track Council.
