Price Money

There is a purse of \$1500 available for the QE2 Twilight Series, available to athletes in the Open category, to be distributed as follows in each Men and Women:

Overall Series Winner: \$200
Overall second: \$150
Overall third: \$100
Overall fourth: \$50

Points awarded for top-eight places as follows:

1st = 10pts, 2nd= 8pts, 3rd= 6pts, 4th= 5pts, 5th= 4pt, 6th= 3pts, 7th= 2pts, 8th= 1pt
Only top-4 best placings (open events) count towards the point standings.

Ties will be broken based on the highest score (IAAF Point tables) during the Series Final, July 29.
 You must be present at the Series Final (July 29) to win your prize money.
 Participants who are not members of Athletics Alberta will not be considered for prize money.

Additional prizes for top performances in the Series Final, July 29 in Airdrie (Male OR Female):

Best sprints/hurdles performance: \$100

Best distance performance: \$100

Best jumps performance: \$100

Best throws performance: \$100

Overall top performance (In Final - as voted by meet management): \$100

Midget Grand Prix (over 4 meets): Medals for top-5.

Points awarded for top-eight places as follows:

1st = 10pts, 2nd= 8pts, 3rd= 6pts, 4th= 5pts, 5th= 4pt, 6th= 3pts, 7th= 2pts, 8th= 1pt

Only top 6 placings (midget events) count towards the point standings.

Ties will not be broken.
